From the Principal's Desk



At a recent conference I was challenged to think about the purpose of schooling. From a non-educationist perspective, this may seem like a rather peculiar question for a Principal to be contemplating. Perhaps it's a little like asking a plumber why they plumb. Obviously the plumber needs an income to survive. However, when all is said and done they provide a service. Establishing or maintaining existing household or commercial properties with the necessary reticulation to allow a comfortable, safe and hygienic level of access to water and gas, and the removal of wastes is a significant service. It is one we tend to take for granted until, the septic tank overflows or there is no hot water, or you visit a developing country with no water supply close to the living area.

There is little doubt schooling is about learning and learning leads to growth; growth in skills, understanding, knowledge, wisdom and character to name a few. I believe life is a journey of learning and living in response to the learning that has taken place. A lesson learned in character development should change a heart to reflect this lesson and so ones character is shaped. A lesson in science gives us a better understanding into the world we live in and a greater understanding of our Creator. Learning from scripture introduces us a little more to our Heavenly Fathers plan for His people, His love for us and His character.

Learning as we know it begins in the womb and ends in the tomb. It never stops. Whilst we may no longer attend a "school" to learn, if faced with a problem, a question, or develop a new interest, we will take the time to learn about it through books, google, YouTube and speaking to others. Developing a passion for learning is not only the responsibility of established institutions, this passion can be encouraged and "hot housed" in the home. Research indicates parents who value learning and are indeed passionate about learning themselves, instill this passion into their children.

Here are some questions that may allow you to gauge the passion you place on our children's learning:

- Do I have a definite purpose for my child's learning?
- Am I intentional in what I do as a parent to assist my child's learning?
- Do I see myself as a very influential determinant in my child's success or failure?
- Do I actively engage with my child's teacher to discuss strategies for my child's successful learning?
- Am I aware of the core values and beliefs of the school and do I actively support them and live them?
- Do I actively involve myself in the mission and vision of the school by volunteering to assist and offer experience, gifts and talents?
