Terms and Conditions of Instrumental and Vocal Tuition

1. Before commencement of lessons, the Instrument and Vocal Tuition Application Form must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian.
2. Tuition fees are charged at \$30.00 per half hour lessons.
3. Fees are invoiced directly to the parents by the Music Tutor, each school term. The School holds no responsibility for the billing or collection of private music student fees.
4. Fees must be paid in advance, at the beginning of each term.
5. Lessons will be suspended if full payment is not received by Week 2 of the term.
6. Students must commit to a full school term of lessons.
7. Enrolments may be cancelled, giving four weeks' notice to the respective Music Tutor, by the dates outlined below:
 - **Friday, 10th March** for withdrawal at the end of Term 1, 2017
 - **Friday, 26th May** for withdrawal at the end of Term 2, 2017
 - **Friday, 25th August** for withdrawal at the end of Term 3, 2017
 - **Thursday, 16th November** for withdrawal at the end of Term 4, 2017
8. Where insufficient notice of withdrawal is given, payment equivalent to 4 lessons from the date the withdrawal notification is received will be required in lieu of notice.
9. Lessons are conducted on a rotational basis during school hours, to minimise disruption to the same classroom lesson each week. (E.g. 9.00am Monday, Week 1, /9.30am Monday, Week 2, etc.)
10. Music tutors are to be notified two full weeks in advance if a student cannot attend a lesson because of a school camp, sports carnival, excursion or incursion, to avoid forfeiting fees.
11. Where a student fails to attend a lesson at the scheduled time; normal charges will apply.
12. Lessons will be rescheduled should a Music Tutor be absent on the day of scheduled lessons.
